We are accepting applications for our annual Waynesboro Summer Jubilee. The celebration will be held on Wednesday, July 4th, 2018 from 8:00 am until after our firework display.

The Waynesboro Summer Jubilee is a patriotic festival held each summer in Waynesboro, Pennsylvania to celebrate the 4th of July holiday. The celebration features a full day of free entertainment, patriotic exhibits and exciting activities for children and adults of all ages.

The day begins with a 1 Mile Kid's Fun Run, then a standard 5K Run, followed by a patriotic parade. The event offers live entertainment, a variety of food and drinks, a craft show, and concludes with the annual fireworks display at dusk.

The craft show is located in Waynesboro on Route 16, across from the Waynesboro Hospital at 501 East Main Street. **Vendors are to enter from Main Street and depart on Enterprise Ave by Savage Family Pharmacy.**

The cost for a 12' x 12' space is \$35.00. Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs and tents. Please note: there is no electric service available. We request that all vendors remain until 4:00 pm, but may stay until 5:00 pm. Food and port-a-potties are located on site.

Summer Jubilee staff reserves the right to dismiss any vendor that does not comply with our family event, for example exhibiting inappropriate behavior or merchandise. Failure to respect these rules will result in not only removal from the grounds, but will prohibit the vendor to participate in future years.
